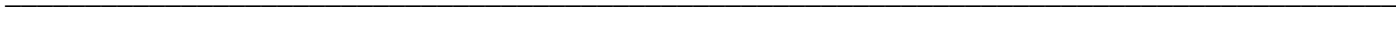
Pool Party

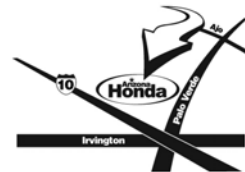
