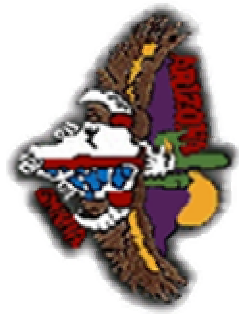

## RIDING NAKED 2

Last month I addressed the first version of this title which covered safety gear to use while riding. There is another aspect of all this which I thought might fit within the same title context, hence the second version.

We will presume that you the rider and co-rider follow the guidelines of wearing the proper safety gear, all the time, and keep that gear in sound condition.

Now the rest of the story as one famous personality says. Borrowing from an article in Motorcycle Consumer News, Fred Rau's Stupid Theories, I found a few tidbits that fit this month's article. First the Stupid Theories or myths. "Avoid using the front brake whenever possible. In a panic situation it will only cause you to be thrown over the handlebars and into traffic." "If the law allows, don't wear a helmet. Where it is the law, get one of those little skull caps. A regular helmet will take away your peripheral vision, so you won't see cars coming from the side, and in warm weather it will cause your brain to overheat." "In almost any kind of emergency situation, you are better off to "lay the bike down" and bail out, than you are to try to brake or swerve". "To keep from overheating (which will cause you to lose your concentration), when riding in the heat, wear only a T-shirt and maybe even some shorts". "When going around a low speed turn, drag your feet so you can "catch" the bike if it starts to fall over. Same for when starting out or coming to a stop". **No wonder you see so much foot shuffling at traffic controls!** And finally, the granddaddy of all myths, "Having a couple of beers before a ride will help you stay "loose". In the event of an accident, your injuries will be less severe, because you won't tense up".

Riding without proper training skills is **riding naked**. Even though many of us have taken various riding courses, the practice or negligence of not keeping our skills updated or upgraded is once again **riding naked**. In essence, we **clothe** ourselves skill wise to create physical and mental reactions to riding situations. It is that feeling of riding **fully clothed** which allows us to access the inputs from the motorcycle, transfer these to the brain, and then back down the nervous system to eyes, hands, and feet. When an adverse riding situation develops, it is those **totally clothed** mental and physical skills that allow us to us to perform **SIPDE**. To see, interpret, predict, decide, and execute those maneuvers which keep us upright while avoiding the impending adverse interaction is our response to the opposite; **riding naked**. Riding naked skill wise only allows the impending interaction to become reality through "brain and body lockup" rather than the trained reflex actions which guide us out of danger.

**Don't ride skill challenged, naked so to speak!** The myths and/or stupid theories, mentioned above are only that; myths and ignorance. Ride as if your life depended on your clothing of body coverings, mental, and physical skills. In reality, it does!

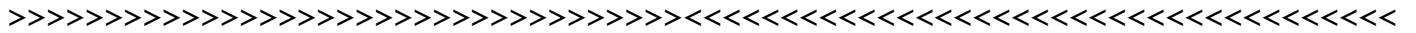

Some of you know about the Been There, Done That (BTDT) ride program. This is a photo tour of various points around Arizona to earn pins and recognition of having "been there, done that."

Since inception at Chapter S this was run by Chuck Donaldson and Don Spongberg. They have stepped down and I volunteered to take over the program. I am planning on making some changes, including making this an Arizona District program, not just one chapter. The program is well established and the primary map points will not change (except one, which I discovered requires 20 miles of gravel road to obtain!).

Changes suggested:

1. The pin will be revised to Arizona District (AZ flag background). The area bars will remain as they are.
2. The sub-points will be refined to make the program appear less complex.
3. The price will be reduced (once I get a new pin made), to cover just basic costs.
4. Any profits will be donated to the Ride for Kids, split by chapter participation.
5. Been There, Done That will be coordinated at chapter level, with me as the focal point for pins, etc. This includes the maintenance of chapter participation and collection of photos. NOTE: This can be a great way to start, or add to your Chapter Scrapbook.

From individual chapters, I would like to have a coordinator for this program. Logically that would be your Ride Coordinator. This can be a great tool for planning chapter rides, with objectives and rewards for obtaining them. And its a lot of fun - I have finally completed the four photo bars after 3.5 years..!

I have another reason - this can be a way for Ride Coordinators to contact each other and maybe plan some joint rides, or meet at a location. Too many times we find we are riding somewhere near another chapter's rides. I plan to put a monthly newsletter out on the achievements in this program.

I know many of you are not familiar with the program, so I'm attaching the current program details. These will be altered over the next few weeks and I will have them for you by January, 2007.

Please send me an email/phone number for your chapter BTDT Coordinator.

NOTE: for those members already enrolled, the program continues "as is." The pin points will not substantially change, so everyone who has sent in photos already qualifies for them. I will send the database information to the BTDT Coordinators once the program is revised.

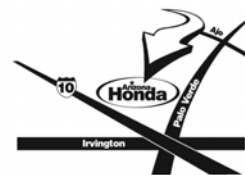
