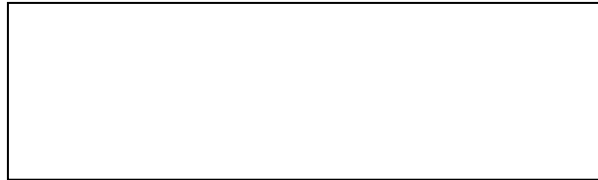

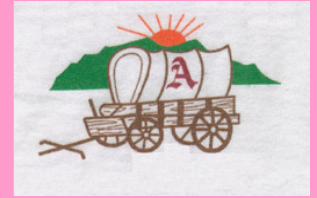

HEARTS TO HEROES

Have you ever seen about 4,000 folks on motorcycles set to ride through parts of Phoenix just to show their appreciation for all military personnel who have guarded our FREEDOM? This writer shared that excitement with motorcycles and folks all pointed in the same direction, to support our troops this past Saturday, April 14, 2007. We have never seen that many motorcycles assembled in any one place for any reason. Goldwing Road Riders from all over the state came to show our support with every other imaginable motorcycle and their riders. I am not sure if there is a manufacturer that wasn't represented. We registered at a huge church on W. Happy Valley Rd. in Phoenix, Arizona along with thousands of other riders and turned in our care packages to be sent to our troops. After coffee and donuts we sat in a gigantic auditorium and were entertained and shared some heart wrenching stories with people who actually are there or have been and made it back home. I don't care how big of a person you think you are but when we heard some of the heartaches there were not many, if any, eyes that remained dry. Now they fired up these 20 foot square screens and before our very eyes we were in Iraq and talking with field generals, officers and enlisted people just like I'm here talking with you. These soldiers shared with us about how proud they are to be there doing their job, protecting the freedom we have always known and knowing that their own families and friends get to live in a country that believes people should be free under GOD. Barry Carraway stood on that stage and asked if the following soldiers were in the room in Iraq and some of them did identify themselves as the camera did a close up each of them. He asked how they were doing and if they missed being home and of course they do miss home, but not one of them


said they would come home until they finished their job. We hear a lot of stuff from the media, but we heard from those guys the honest truth. We wondered what could be next that could possibly tear into our hearts once again, well we found out. On our stage in Phoenix, at that very church, some civilian folks were escorted on to the floor in front of those cameras. Those soldiers, who were asked to come forward in Iraq, now stood face to face with their very own mothers, grandmothers, dads, wives, husbands and children and spoke on live television. Now you tell me that the hair on your arm doesn't stand up and your eyes don't feel teary, this was truly an emotional moment. That's not the end, we mounted our bikes and were escorted by our Arizona Highway Patrol and every police agency, non stop, to Phoenix International Raceway, were we actually rode our motorcycles around the racetrack for about a lap and a half, ever done that? Keep in mind we are still thousands of motorcycles and there in the infield lined up on the wall were NASCAR crews, racing at PIR next weekend, and they were saluting us, ever done that? We excited the raceway and continued our uninterrupted column right past Luke Air force Base. People lined parts of the road, waving flags, blowing horns and showing peace signs and thank you for all of us. We went right past the University of Phoenix, and Arizona Cardinal NFL Stadiums, and concluded our ride at the Westgate Mall. The center of the mall was cleared for us and in the middle was a stage with live entertainment and food just for us, ever done that? I tried to thank Barry and his people for allowing us to be part of the most emotional motorcycle ride I have ever been close to, but I didn't have enough words. He looked at me and said thank you for being part of this and oh by the way bring two more people with you next year.

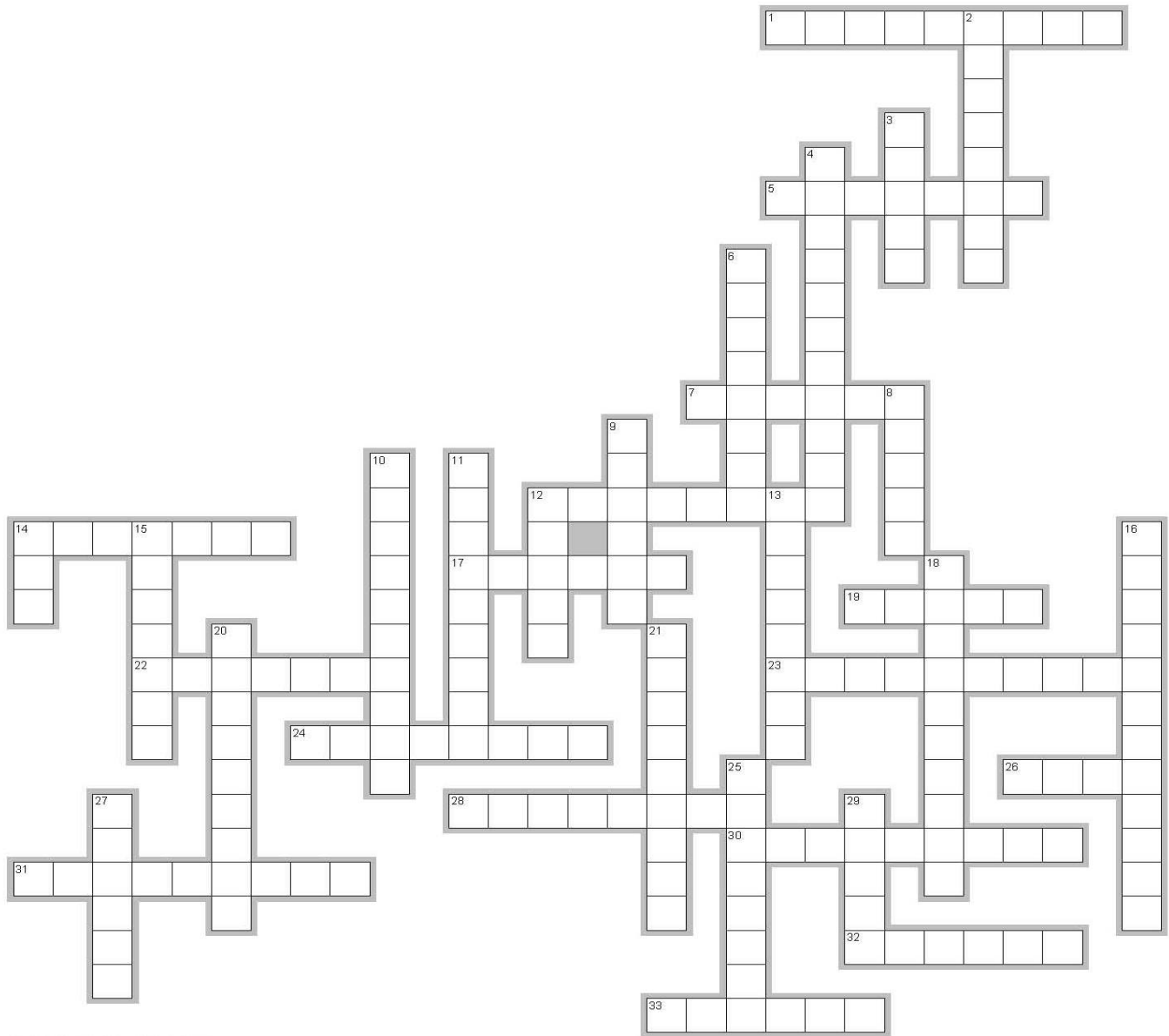
